Is classical music better than modern music?

The purpose of this essay is to discuss whether classical music is better than modern music.

I think that classical music has no place in the 21st century. I judge this because modern music is replacing classic music for the future generation. Examples of modern music are pop music, r&b music, rap music, dance music and garage music.

I judge that modern music consists of many new techniques that weren't discovered in early days.

When I use the word 'techniques' I mean devices such as DJ system, music mixing devices etc.

I think this because for example Mozart, Wolfgang Amadeus was one of the most inspired composers in the western Musical tradition, and he was an Austrian composer. This was because Mozart was a brilliant classical composer and played his music well. Mozart had the skills, which the modern people would lack in having any knowledge of at all. For example, Mozart had the ability in sight reading and making it up as you go along which is rather in my opinion a difficult skill to follow.

I judge that classical music has better value than modern music because famous composers like Mozart composed 15 piano concertos before the end of 1786 so that he could appear both as composer and as a soloist.

Mozart has developed one of the famous opera called Idomeneo that was considered to be the greatest knowledge of composition of Mozart.
