RDB (Rhythm Dhol and Bass) have already established themselves has a household name in the UK and International bhangra scene as one of the most talented production and entertainment groups of the century.

RDB are essentially a group of three brothers from Leeds (Kuly, Manj and Surj) who over the past four years have not only been performing in front of thousands of people in the UK's top clubs, Melas and parties, but also on the worlwide DJ circuit. Spreading the RDB flava from coast to coast and performing to litterally thousands of bhangra fans in countries such as USA, Canada, Belgium, Austria, Dubai, Singapore, India, New Zealand and Austrailia.

These essential club DJs, play a blend of Bhangra, House and Garage, Hindi, RnB, Hiphop, Ragga and Dance music, but with a skillful difference. Even having firmly established a fan base in every corner of the world, the RDB team never forget their own country, the UK, where they have performed in almost every top club known to the clubbing world.

However, these boys aren't just simply DJs.... since the release of their first album (RDB - The debut) on UntouchablesUk.com Records, the group has changed the UK bhangra scene forever. Coupling together there knowledge of the live circuit with the expertise of high-end production, they have developed a style of music that only can be described as the RDB sound.

Their music can be heard all over the UK, from London, through the midlands, right up to the mountains of Scotland; being banged out in clubs by DJs, dropp ed in ICE systems on the streets and of course danced to at weddings and melas.

Since July 2001, RDB have released five chart topping albums, all of which have enjoyed the no.1 spot on all bhangra charts for over three to four weeks.

Working together, each with their own talents, the RDB team have worked with singers and musicians from all over the world. From the likes of Kuldeep Manak, Surinder Shinda, Ranjit Mani to many other top groups and vocalists from India and the UK.

After the success of the first album, the RDB team designed and built their own 74 track digital studio. Based in Leeds, the studio runs a Mackie D8B digital mixing desk, along with a host of synths, keyboards and samplers to create the clean crisp sounds of the RDB albums. All mixing and mastering is done in-house by the team and combined with their own musical talents they bring the sound and energy of bhangra into a new club hitting, bass dropping, hype flava.

Apart from producing and Djing, all 3 brothers can play a variety of instruments from dhol, dholki, tabla, harmonium to keyboards and drums and with the other RDB members like Lethal Dholis, Indy Sagu, MCP and De Jav expanding the RDB skills, the group can produce amazing original music for all genres, from desi classical to underground garage.
