## The comparison between Tesco & Sainsburys Amir Latif

#### **Introduction:**

I am to make a price comparison of Tesco to Sainsbury. I had made the following steps to research, I had the information about the turnover of Tesco and Sainsburys in the last few years. I also had a list of items taken from Tesco and Sainsburys (Own branded, Branded and fruit and veg). I then had a shopping basket to do a price comparison between the two stores in a week and a year etc...

The following is my coursework:

It is shown in my price list comparison that Tesco is cheaper in price than Sainsburys. I have also researched and found out that Tesco's turnover is much higher than Sainsburys, from 1999 to 2001. In 1999 the turnover of Tesco was £17,158.00 m however Sainsburys turnover in 1999 was £16,433.00 m, the difference is that Tesco made £725.00 m turnover more than Sainsburys. Those results were only 1999, there are also results of turnover for 2000 which is the following:

In 2000 Tesco's turnover (in BP) was £18,796.00 m, were as Sainsburys turnover in 2000 was £16,271.00 m, thus the turnover difference between the two was Tesco made £2,525.00 m more turnover than Sainburys. As you can see in this result that Tesco is making more money in 1999 and in 2000, also that Sainsburys turnover in 1999 to 2000 did not increase but decreased. Therefore Sainsburys was doing badly in 1999 and 2000 compared to Tesco, but Sainsburys did improve over the next years but it was still not making as much turnover as Tesco was, thus Tesco must have more customers than Sainsburys and they are selling more products than Sainsburys. Sainsburys is not competing as well against Tesco as Tesco is against Sainsburys, I personally believe that this may possibly be due to the fact that Sainsburys prices are higher than Tesco's.



One of the reasons for why Tesco have lower prices than a lot of companies is because it is competing against other companies such as Sainsburys, Waitross, Asda. Competition also help the companies keep their prices down because if they do not it would mean that the other store would have more customers. The company which has the higher price would make less money due to low amount of customers etc... It is also why they advertise their prices like all other companies.

I have also done a shopping list for 1 week use which would help me decide in long and short term which supermarket (Tesco or Sainsburys) is cheaper to shop in.

# There Is A Limit Of £40 To Spend In 1 Week For Shopping

The research shows that I have £40 to spend on one week of shopping in both shops, the result was I saved £5 in Tesco and I saved £3.83 in Sainsburys using the same shopping basket as Tesco. This also helps me show that you would save much more in Tesco in a year than you would in Sainsburys in a year. In Tesco you would save £260 using the same shopping basket everyone week and having £40 to spend every week. The results for Sainsburys using the same shopping basket as Tesco and having £40 every week to spend for a whole year was that you would save £199.16 in a whole year. The difference in how much you would save in each shop would be that you would save £60.84 more in Tesco than you would in Sainsburys. Even thought £60.84

May not seem like too much money. It is one other reason for why you would rather buy from Tesco rather than Sainsburys





There are also ways that the company keep their customers. Examples of how they keep their customers is that both companies have created a club card which makes the customer more likely to return to the supermarket they got their club card from rather than going to a supermarket which they are unfamiliar with. Therefore club card do help companies a lot this is why both Sainsburys and Tesco have got club cards to keep their customers loyal.

There are also reasons for why Tesco or Sainsburys sometimes have such a big difference in price on some products. This is because some products are higher in demand than they are in other places; thus the supermarket which has a product higher in demand would put their prices down. This is also a bigger problems for the supermarket with the higher price as it may take customers away from them as they may prefer the price in the supermarket with the higher demand product, which is what has happened to Sainsburys in a way. This is all to do with competition as you may know.

The following show three bar graphs that shows the difference in price on a certain product type:





Tesco have also opened up for longer hours which has made them much more money. They are also convenient for people to get to as it very near to the station in Finchley (I also have a map of where the superstore is to show also were the station is). Which has created another problem for the Sainsburys in Finchley as it more difficult for them to find a better location than Tesco. Tesco have not got a better transport route for customers than Sainsburys do, also Tesco have a very large car park which is also very convenient for people who own cars (even thought Sainsburys do too). Which is also why customer chooses a store over another. Neither of them have a full local monopoly as they both have many customers and if Tesco changed the prices higher customer might decide to go to Sainsburys. Therefore they cannot hold control of the prices people have to pay to buy the goods, as there are other supermarkets in the local area they can shop from. But there is a local monopoly for certain goods as there is high demand of certain goods in a supermarket than in the other supermarket as mentioned above.

There is a time when Sainsburys copies Tesco or Tesco copies, example: club card, which was a good idea that is why one supermarket followed the other. As far as I can see from the results etc, I see Tesco as a more successful company than Sainsburys the local as well as national.

I did have a few problems with getting the information as some products where not available in certain supermarkets, which is why I picked the closest type of product from the store to the product of the other store. The problems I had with compiling my price survey did not have an effect on my conclusion.

My conclusion is that Tesco in whole is a more successful company in my local area as well as nationally for the reasons above and the research I have made to use as evidence of my statements.
