Quality of Life Interview

For this survey to be completed, the following equipment is needed,

1. The survey sheet
2. A pen/pencil
3. 10 people to question

10 members of the public are needed for you to ask them to answer 6 questions. The public can be found near shops, on the streets or if no one was found, say on a rainy day, it would be relevant if you politely knock on a door and then ask the questions.

The 6 questions are: -

1. Your house
2. Number/type/quality of shops in the area.
3. Friendliness of the area
4. Your personal security and safety
5. The appearance and tidiness of the area
6. Their age

Read out the questions to the person then the scores. Ask him/her to tell you the score of the questions. The scores are 2 for extreme, 1 for satisfied and 0 for dissatisfied, once they have told you then you can write down the score on the survey sheet.

When you have asked 10 members of the public, total them up in the Total column, and then do an overall total out of 100 at the bottom of the sheet. Make sure to get a mixture of males and females at different age ranges so the survey is not biased and all the views of the public are considered.
