Is there a bright future for Bradley Stoke?

When the houses were built they were quite expensive and the value of land was rising quite rapidly. This attracted many people who thought that the prices would keep on increasing and so many people bought houses here.

This caused a big problem as less people than the developers had hoped moved in, which meant that not many shops or play areas could be built due to the poor funding. Q: What type of family would you recommend Bradley Stoke?

A: Not a single man, but a family with younger kids who go to primary school.

The only part that has worked out is probably the housing, however, the rest hasn't quite been that successful as there are no community buildings, very few leisure facilities and nothing to do for the older kids here.
