Mouse	A mouse is used to control what happens on the screen. There is generally 2 buttons left click selects an item and right click brings up a relevant menu. Most people are used to using a mouse so no one would need any training to use a mouse. But overuse of a mouse can lead to repetitive strain injury. The motherboard connects all of the components together, so without this nothing would work because none of the connections between wires will be made.
Sound Card	A sound card is a computer expansion card that facilitates the input and output of audio signals. The term sound card is also applied to external audio interfaces that use software to generate sound, as opposed to using hardware inside the PC. John needs a good sound card so when the sound is projected from the computer to the speakers or headphones the quality of the sound will be clear.
