**To what extent is this true?**

# AIM

1. I aim to find out whether the media does actually portray ethnic minorities in a negative way and if so how.
2. I aim to investigate what reasons arise when ethnic minorities are portrayed in a negative way.
3. I will use primary research to find out other peoples opinions and to see if people do agree with my hypothesis.
4. I will use secondary research to define key concepts and to support my primary research.
5. I will prove my hypothesis.

# **INTRODUCTION**

I wish to research this particular topic 'The media portrays ethnic minorities in a negative way' because of personal experiences that I have had which relates back to the topic. I am a young Asian teenager and I have faced many problems when I'm on the streets with friends, i.e. I crossed the road when I saw a group of young black youths because I had seen and heard about crimes which had been committed by young black youths on the news and when I did they crossed over and attacked me and my sister by throwing food at us, I only crossed the road because of what I had heard and by them attacking me and my sister it had been proven to me that whatever is written/shown in the media is based on true facts and because of ethnic minorities and their behaviour the media does show them in a negative way and they are responsible for it, and this is a reason why I want to prove that although the media does portray ethnic minorities in a negative way ethnic minorities are responsible for it because they behave in such a way that the media decides to portray ethnic minorities in a negative way. Also further more I want to find out whether the public does agree with me, which would help to prove my hypothesis.

I believe this is a sociological topic because where there is ethnicity and gender discrimination; people's work chances and life chances would get affected because they will have no source of income and they will become ill and die. When ethnic minorities would try to get a job, people would discriminate against them and think of them in a negative way so then they wouldn't be able to get a job, and not having a job would lessen down their life chances. The reason for discrimination against ethnic minorities is that ethnic minorities may not be educated that much to get a job, and not having a job means no source of income, so some may turn to crime (but not all), and when the media come to know about this they start to create a big issue about it and actually start to portray all ethnic minorities in a negative way, and then non-ethnic minorities tend to believe it's true that they act differently towards ethnic minorities because of what they have heard/seen on the media.

Also these issues are important in Britain today because some innocent ethnic minorities are discriminated by employers just because of their race and this is affecting the amount of unemployed people in Britain today, and because of discrimination towards ethnic minorities it is raising the amount of unemployed people in Britain today.

# **METHODOLOGY**

## **Primary Research**

For my primary research I will carry out a simple questionnaire to help me get a view on what the public think about ethnic minorities when it comes to crime, although this is not linking to my hypothesis, but finding out what the public think will help me to see why they think this and is it the media which is causing. I feel that creating a questionnaire will help me to see whether or not the public does agree with what I am aiming to find out; whether the media actually does show ethnic minorities in a negative way and why.

The advantages for this kind of method is that it will give me both sides of the argument and this will give me some kind of understanding on what the public thinks, I believe this is important because if I don't get both sides of the argument then I wouldn't know if I proved my hypothesis, by having both sides of the arguments, also by having a one sided view will make me think that the public were being biased and giving false data, and this would affect my results. Also using the questionnaire method is a quick, cheap and easy way to find out information from the public, and some people may want to remain anonymous so it is a good way and it will help me to get more answers and the public won't have to worry about there information being passed on because some people may ask for names and may ask personal questions, and some people may be too shy/worried to give out such information. Whereas in my case some people may be too afraid to tell what ethnicity they think may harm them when they're outside by themselves, because they don't want other people to know who they're more worried about and who not.

The disadvantages for this method is that some people may be biased and not answer the questions honestly, also that people might treat it as a joke and then again not answer the questions honestly, also some people may not understand the question and give anything for an answer and by doing this it will not be fair on my research because I would have false answers, making my results invalid and false, so I would be wrong to use them as they are made up and false and this would affect my coursework as I haven't got valid results. I felt that if I did an interview some people may not tell the truth because it is based on crimes, and I may ask

them questions which they may not want to give a personal view on, because they might be too afraid to share their views as they may think the person taking the interview might think of them in a different way and might also share the information given with other people. I will try to overcome these disadvantages by making all the questions clear and easy to read and understand, also not to include any information which I think is biased to make my research fair. I would select my sample by picking random people from all year groups plus teachers, also different ethnicities, I have decided to this because I then wouldn't be aiming for anyone individual just anyone who I come across.

## Secondary Research

For my secondary research I want to use a lot of different types of methods because it will give me to get various ideas; the internet, newspapers/news, textbooks and documentaries.

I want to use sociology textbooks such as "(Name Of A Sociology Textbook Needed Here)" to help me find relative information on whether the media does portray ethnic minorities in a negative way, by looking in sociology text books I will be able to find out if anyone else has tried to prove a similar hypothesis to mine and if they have I can use their data to support my hypothesis. The disadvantage of this method is that some people may not have tried to prove a similar hypothesis to mine.

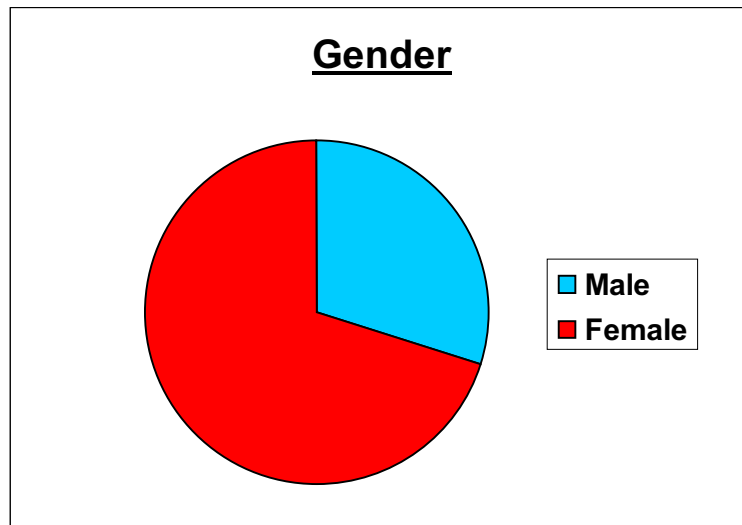

# Results

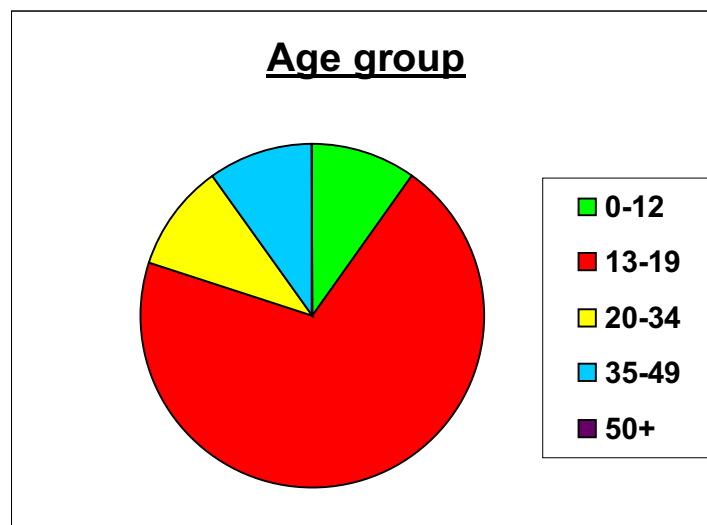
I finally carried out my questionnaire and here are the results (I believe by looking at the results I have received all the information I need to prove my hypothesis);

What age group do you belong to?

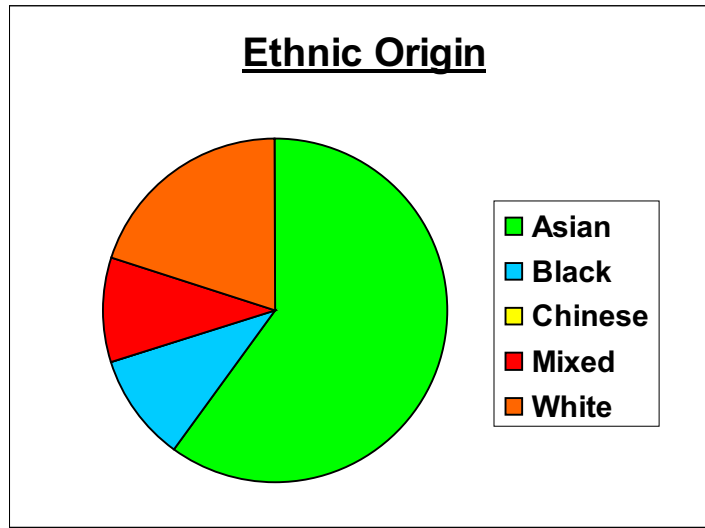


- 10% 0-12 yrs

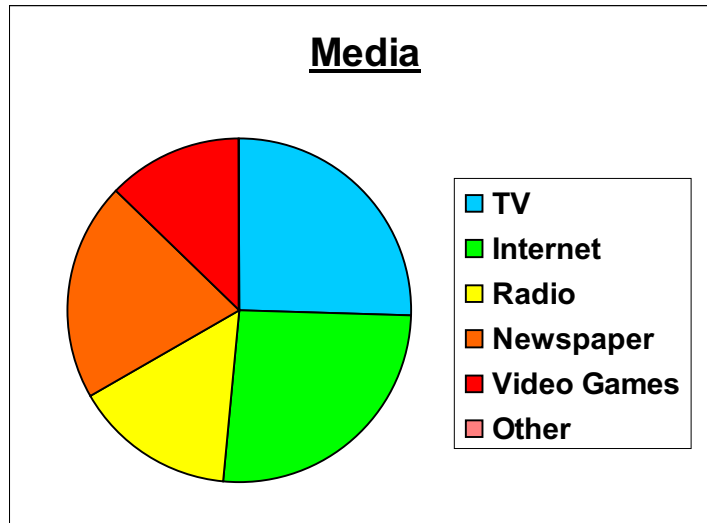
### What is your ethnic origin?

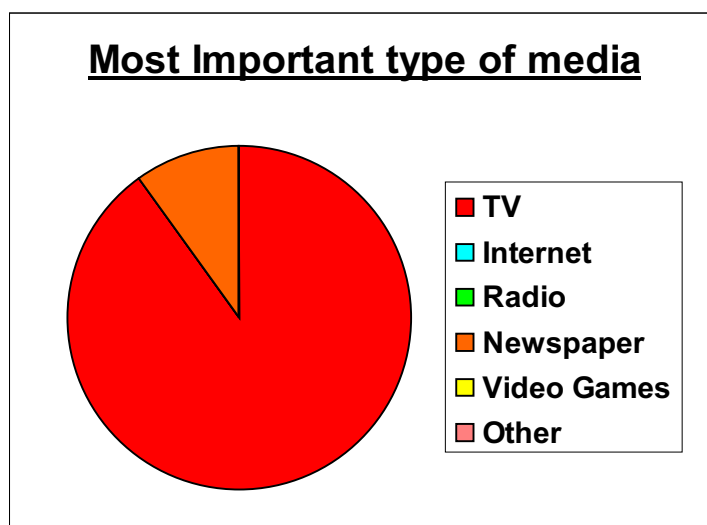
### What types of media do you come across on a daily bases?

- 10% said the Newspaper is the most important type of media.

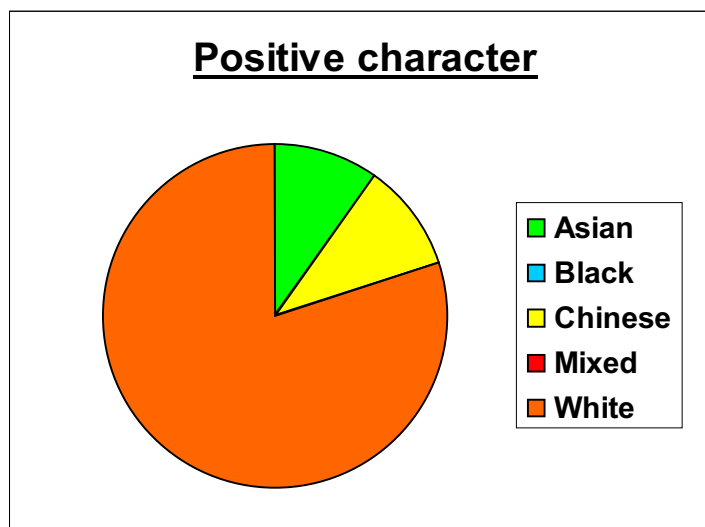
90% of the people said that TV was the most important type media because on the TV you can view visual things in much more detail, because you could access the news more easily, it also influences

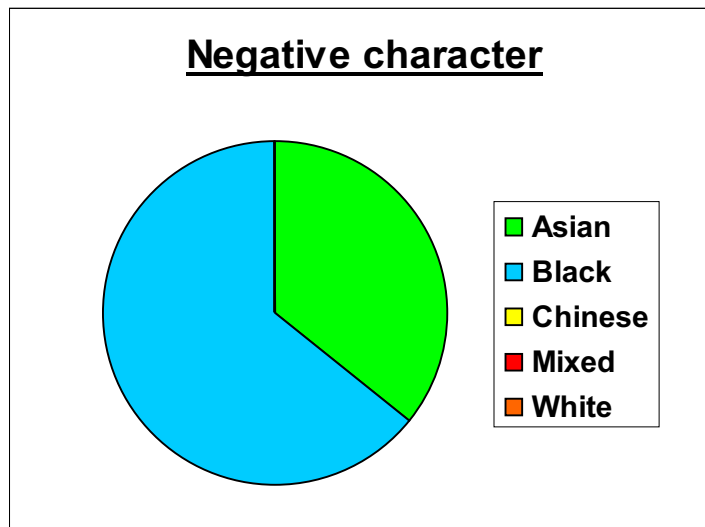
If you have ticked; TV/Video games, what ethnicity is more likely to be a positive character?

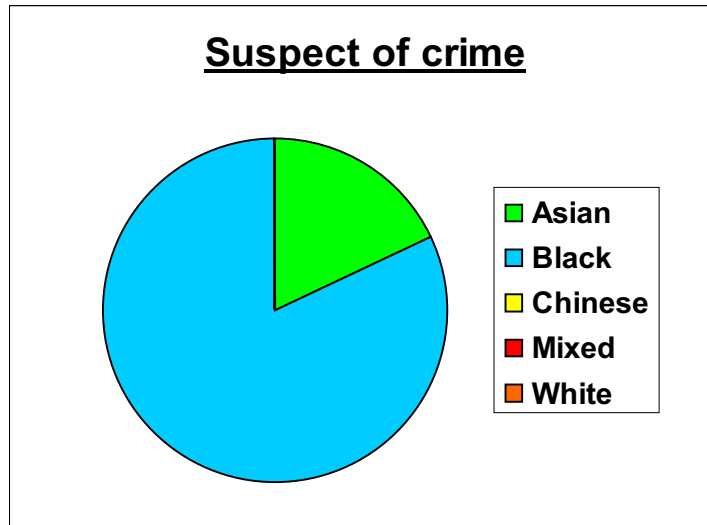
## What about a negative character?

What about the news; what ethnicity is more likely to be a suspect of a crime?

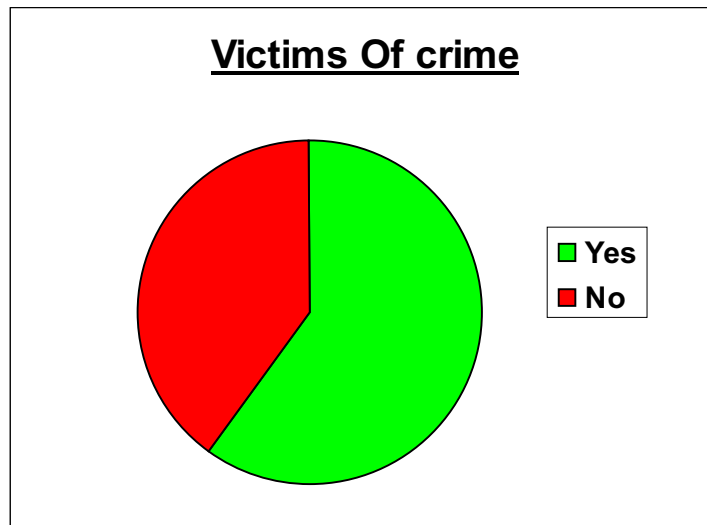


- 18% Asian

**Have you been a victim of a crime?**

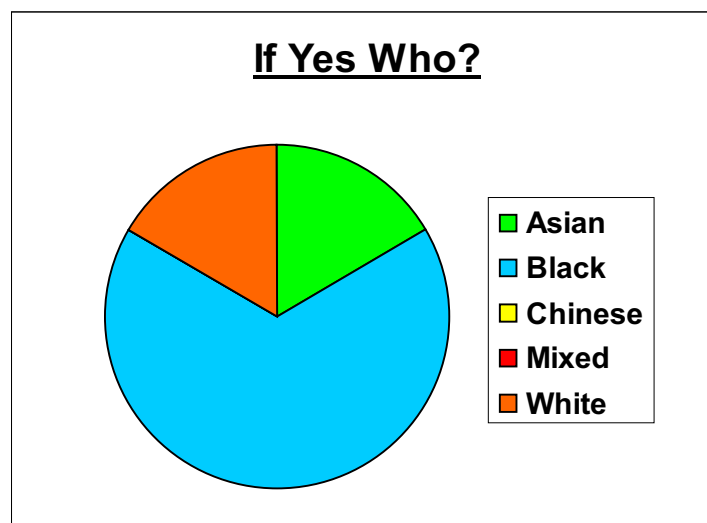




- 60% Yes

If yes; what ethnicity was the person who committed the crime?

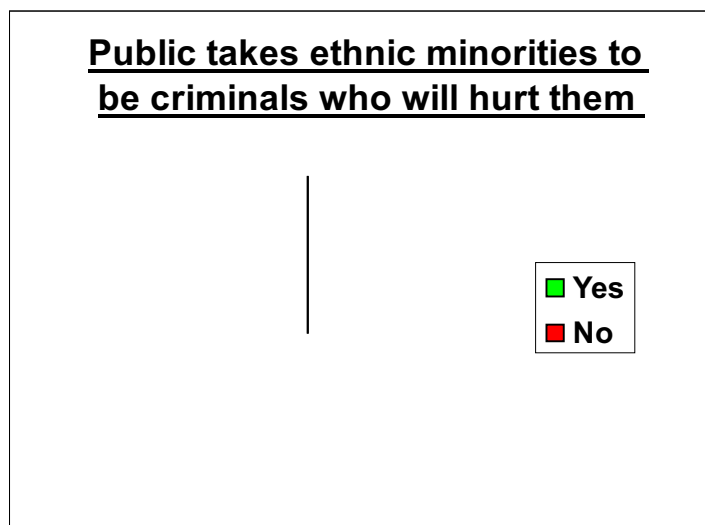


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I asked this question because in the previous question I asked if they had been a victim of a crime, and if they had they were to answer this question, and I wanted to know

Do you think the public takes ethnic minorities to be criminals who will hurt others around them (Please state your reason why)?



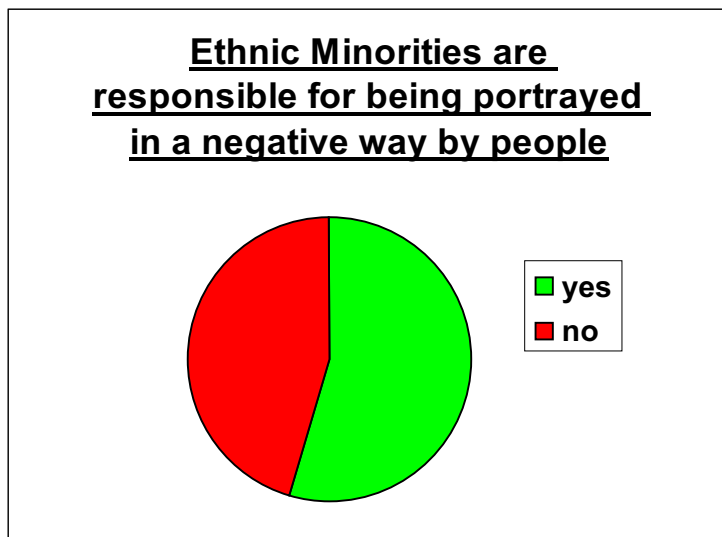
- 100%-Yes

Do You Think Ethnic Minorities are responsible for the way they are portrayed by people?



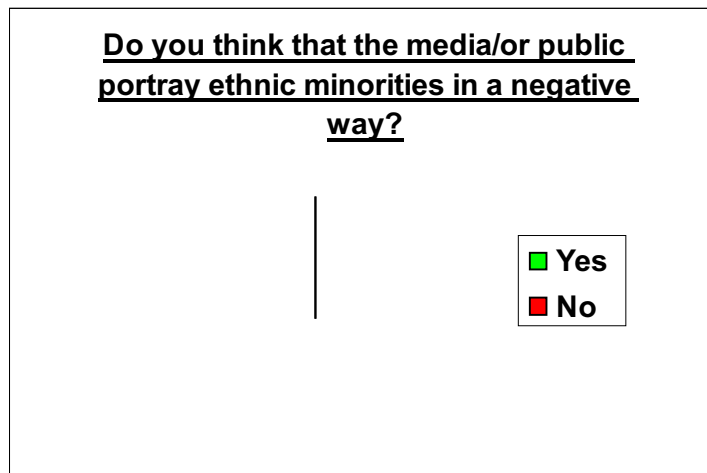
- 55% Yes

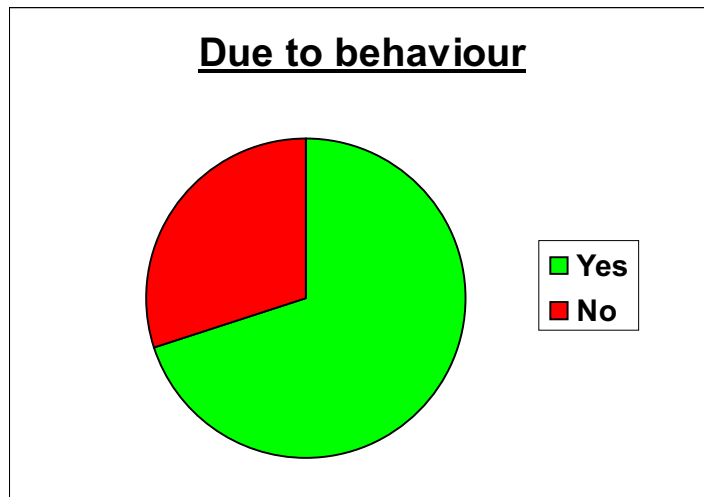
Do you think that the media/or public portray ethnic minorities in a negative way?

If YES, do you think it's due to behaviour in society that ethnic minorities are portrayed in a negative way? (Please specify why you think this?)

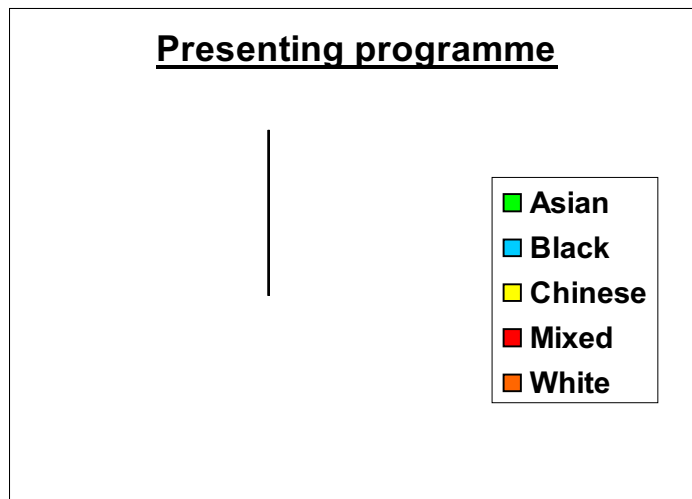


- 70% Yes

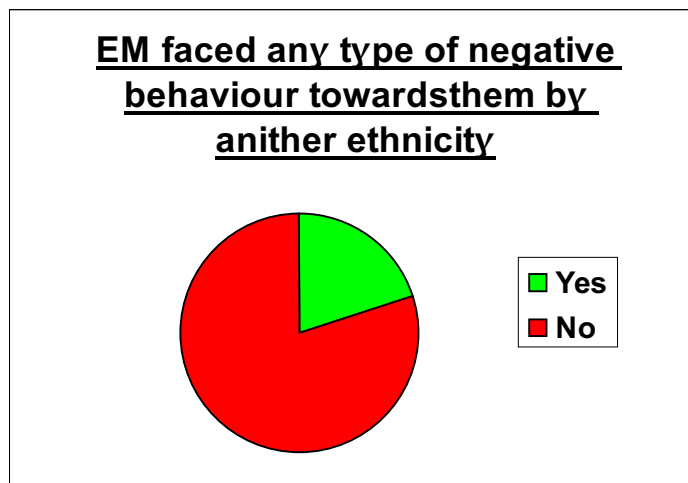

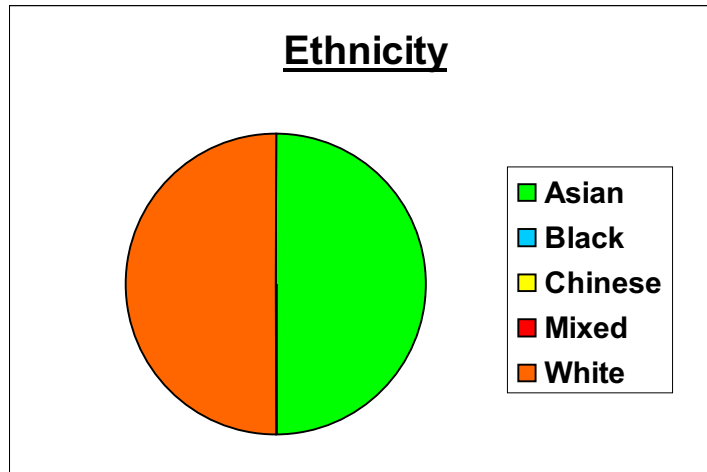

# Analysis

(Only 2 people said yes)

The aim of my research was to find out whether or not I could actually prove my hypothesis which was to see whether the media portrays ethnic minorities in a negative way. I used a primary research method and a secondary research method to help me to prove my hypothesis.

By carrying out my primary research; a simple questionnaire, I have found out that a lot of people did actually agree with the fact that the media does portray ethnic minorities in a negative way, one of the questions was "If you have ticked; TV/Video games, what ethnicity is more likely to be a positive character?" 80% of the people said that white people are more likely to be shown as positive character and another question which I asked was "What about a negative character?" everyone who filled in my questionnaire said that either Black/Asian were more likely to be a negative character, and my secondary research did help to support this because in the video game there was more black/Asian people as a negative character. By them asking this questionnaire and the answers I received it showed me that by carrying out my primary research, I managed to prove my hypothesis that the media does portray ethnic minorities in a negative way because my primary research showed the media portrays ethnic minorities in a negative

way in this case negative characters are more likely to be ethnic minorities.

The secondary research (the news, TV, videogames and the internet), that I carried out also help me to prove my hypothesis because I decided to analyse video games and TV programmes to see which characters are shown as positive and negative characters, I watched a family member play a violent video game "Grand Theft Auto" I decided to analyse the game and found that most of the negative characters were ethnic minorities and the innocent positive characters were mostly white people, this definitely helped me with proving my hypothesis. But one piece of information I found that during my secondary research was that in a cartoon "The Simpson's" I found that in the cartoon they didn't actually show ethnic minorities in a negative way instead they had white people who were negative characters and they had ethnic minorities as positive characters i.e. police officer, but this couldn't disprove my hypothesis because this was only from one cartoon. This backs up my primary research because I asked people which ethnicity was more likely to be a negative character and all of them said ethnic minorities, and my secondary research has shown me that the answers I got were true and not made-up.

A lot of people agreed that ethnic minorities are responsible for the way they are portrayed by the media because of their behaviour on the streets and literally everywhere, the crimes they commit, people become more aware that ethnic minorities are committing more crimes as it's shown on the news, so they choose to show ethnic minorities as negative characters in video games or in TV programmes i.e. daily soap's or cartoons.

Overall I believe my researches have helped me too prove my hypothesis and in result "The media does portray ethnic minorities in a negative way"



# Evaluation

My hypothesis was “Does the media portray ethnic minorities in a negative way” has been proven and I reached to this conclusion because of my primary and secondary research; my primary research was using a questionnaire to find out what the public thinks and my secondary research was to go through different types of media and see how ethnic minorities are portrayed, i.e. through video games, news papers, TV etc.

My primary research helped me get an idea of what the public thought and whether they agreed with what I thought, and the public did agree with me which made me think that I could prove my hypothesis, and my secondary research helped me to prove my hypothesis overall because I found many pieces of evidence which linked to my hypothesis and also helped me to prove it i.e. crime cases, video games and how the negative characters are always ethnic minorities etc.

I do not regret using a questionnaire for my primary research because I was comfortable handing out questionnaires to everyone, because it was easy and simple to do. This method was very helpful as it helped me to gain quick information, which saved a lot of time. In future if I were to do a questionnaire again I would hand out many questionnaires and decide to aim for a larger sample of people because I would get more views and a better idea.

With my secondary research I was comfortable with what I was doing but it was kind of hard looking through newspapers to find things to help prove my hypothesis, as it took a long time looking through various newspapers, and websites to find articles which would help me with proving my hypothesis, but in the end it was all worth it.

My research methods were successful because they helped me a lot with my research and also help me prove my hypothesis, i.e. my primary research; using a questionnaire help me to see that the public did also believe what I believed; that the media does portray ethnic minorities in a negative way, and my secondary research help to back up my hypothesis with proof that the media does tend to portray ethnic minorities in a negative way.

However I feel that the research methods could be improved. If I was to carry out my research project again and had more again I would hand out many questionnaires and decide to aim for a larger sample of people because I would get more views and a better idea. Also with my secondary research I could have looked more on the Internet, found more different types of crime cases, also analyse more different types of programmes such as crime watch and other crime based programmes and see what they had to say., although because of the lack of time I was unable to do more research, but in the time I had I did whatever I could and I did and the result for it is that I proved my hypothesis.

My hypothesis was proven but my research was limited because my research methods were weak in some areas, i.e. people would not have answered all the questions in my questionnaire properly, I know this because where there was detailed answered questions people would leave it and hand it back, but only some people done this but the majority didn't, so at the moment I am okay with it but in future I would use less detailed questionnaires and make sure the questions are short and easy to answer. Because the research was limited and my research methods were weak in some area, in my secondary research I couldn't find information which I needed i.e. trends, this would also cause a problem because I didn't have enough information to back-up my hypothesis, and the reason for not finding trends was because there wasn't much on there and I didn't have enough time to look through so many websites to find some.

From carrying out my primary research I have learned about society. Moreover, I have learned about the difficulties of research. These included how people may not answer questions properly because they're not that interested in taking part in answering the questions, and I did come across a couple of people who weren't really interested in filling in the questionnaire i.e. students and teachers. I couldn't do anything when I had given out the questionnaire because I had realised that afterwards that some teachers and students weren't that interested, but in future I would ask people if they would be willing to answer every question, and if they're then I would allow them to answer my questionnaire.

Also another thing which I came across was that some people would lie in their answers just to show off and make themselves look better at giving answers, this was also affecting my results because they weren't accurate results. I could tell that's some people were lying i.e. if they said they were an Asian person then why would they say that positive character are more likely to be Chinese; this obviously shows they are lying and trying to be funny.

In the future, I would improve my primary research by handing out my questionnaire to people who I know would give me sensible and reliable answers, also make the questions short and easy so people wouldn't have to spend too long filling it in because that is another reason why people may tend to give biased answers.

Also for my secondary research I would try to leave myself spare time so I could find better results for my secondary research.

I managed to meet most of my aims; the 1<sup>st</sup> one "I aim to find out whether the media does actually does portray ethnic minorities in a negative way" I managed to meet this aim because this was my hypothesis and I actually did prove my hypothesis. 2<sup>nd</sup> aim was "I aim to investigate what reasons arise when ethnic minorities are portrayed in a negative way" I also met this aim because the reason which arise when ethnic minorities are portrayed in a negative way are that ethnic minorities are uneducated, they turn to crime because they have no money etc. 3<sup>rd</sup> aim was "I will use primary research to find out other peoples opinions and if people do agree with what I aim to find out" I also met this aim because thanks to my secondary research I got hope that my hypothesis can be proven, because of the results I got back. 4<sup>th</sup> aim was "I will use secondary research to help make my points stronger with strong proof to backup my points" I didn't completely meet this aim

although I did find some proof to backup my points but I believe I could have done more if I had time. 5<sup>th</sup> aim was "I will try my best to prove my hypothesis" I did try my best I done all I could to prove my hypothesis and I did prove my hypothesis. Overall I believe I have managed to meet all my aims and complete them too.
