THERE ARE FEW MEN WHO ARE STILL ALIVE AND CONSIDER THE WELL BEING OF THEIR WIVES.

According to these messages I think that if people try not thinking what society wants from them and what they can't do but instead thinking what they want in their lives will definitely lead to the achievement that they want in their life. As a female person, I was glad to see how Jacqueline did what she wanted not thinking that being a pilot is only for men. She instead proved these female are not

For instance, the family was shown wealthy and owned their own business. Men were represented as tough, courageous, Asian, and working class. Female were shown attractive, hardworking and homely.

There were particular qualities prevailed among the male characters such as being orking, are employed and maintain a personalitystrong, protective, building muscles, hardw Whereas, female were considered to be introvert, and extrovert when it comes to solve and Female .Female were generally ethical and housekeepers .problem that appears in their lives They are not the workers in the paid labor .of children and home were generally care taker When employed, the types of jobs that they are represented within are generally .force .business textiles and industry

When unemployed, they are shown either applying to the jobs or attending the interviews. Sometimes they are even shown working a small paid job on the street where the poor people tend to work. They are shown with the family in a small low budget restaurant. They reflect the gender roles in a society and how one should behave. There can be generalization made about gender roles from this media in terms of how the male and female act and behave in a certain way that shapes their family together.

THE MESSAGES ABOUT THE MEN IN THIS MEDIA ARE THEY ARE SUPPOSED TO BE STRONG AND SUPPORT THE FAMILY AT THE DIFFICULT SITUATION. THEY SHOULD BE THE ONE BY WHICH FAMILY CAN STAND TOGETHER.

THE MEN ALMOST EXCLUSIVELY FILLED CERTAIN ROLES DURING THE UNEMPLOYMENT THEY ARE THE FIRST PREFERENCE TO GO OUT AND FIND WORK. MEN WERE SHOWN AS BUSINESS PARTNERS, OR OWNERS, OR AS SHARE HOLDERS. MEN WERE NOT ABSENT FROM THE MEDIA. THE MESSAGE ABOUT WOMEN IN THIS MEDIA WAS THEY STAND OUT WHEN THERE IS ANY SITUATION OR PROBLEMS AGAINST THEIR FAMILY. THEY ARE TYPICALLY HOUSE WIVES WHO SERVE THEIR WHOLE LIFE IN THE WELLBEING OF THE FAMILY.

THE WOMEN ALMOST EXCLUSIVELY FILLED A CERTAIN ROLES AS A DAUGHTER, WIFE, MOTHER, AND GRANDMOTHER. NO, WOMEN ARE NOT ABSENT FROM THIS MEDIA. THE RACE -GENDER MIX MESSAGES THAT I OBSERVED WAS MEN WAS INVOLVED IN EARNING INCOME WHERE AS FEMALE WAS INVOLVED IN THE HOUSEHOLD ACTIVITIES. NO, THE MESSAGES THAT I RECEIVED DO NOT ADVANCE THE SOCIAL JUSTICE DUE TO THE FACT THAT EVERYONE SHOULD BE TREATED EQUALLY.

THE MESSAGES REGARDING WOMEN AND THOSE REGARDING MEN DO NOT PROMOTE THE IDEAL EQUALITY PARTICULARLY OF EQUAL OPPORTUNITY BECAUSE THE SOCIETY THAT THEY WERE SHOWN IN HAD THE IDEOLOGY ABOUT GENDER ROLES. IN THE SOCIETY THAT THEY WERE RAISED MAINLY CONSIDERED THE DIFFERENCE IN THE ABILITY OF MEN AND WOMEN. MEN WERE CONSIDERED PRESTIGIOUS AND OUTGOING, WHEREAS WOMEN WERE INTROVERT AND NURTURING THEIR KIDS.

MY CURRENT FAVORITE PROGRAMS ARE MAINLY INDIAN REALITY SHOWS: DANCE INDIA DANCE, SA RE GA MA PA, AND DID DOUBLES. IN ORDER TO ADVANCE SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EQUALITY OF OPPORTUNITY THERE SHOULD BE NO AGE LIMIT AND THEY SHOULD TRY AND SEE HOW UNTRAINED DANCER OR SINGER PERFORM WITHOUT ANY TRAINING BY GIVING THEM ONE CHANCE TO SHOW THEIR SKILLS. MY AUNT WHO LIVES IN CANADA IS MARRIED TO A PERSON FROM UGANDA. THEY ARE ONE OF THE BEST COUPLE KNOWN IN OUR FAMILY. THEY ARE WELL SETTLED, AND HAVE MORE PRESTIGE THAN ANYONE ELSE IN OUR FAMILY. THE PARTNER IS SUPPORTIVE AND HAS A POSITIVE ATTITUDE. THEIR RELATIONSHIP IS LIKE AN EVERLASTING LOVE STORY.

THE RELATIONSHIP IS PORTRAYED AS IMPROVING AND LESSENING TO EVERYONE IN OUR FAMILY. WE LEARN FROM THEIR RELATIONSHIP AND EVEN SOMETIMES GIVE EXAMPLES TO OTHERS ABOUT HOW THEY LEAVE HAPPILY. THIS MADE ME FEEL PROUD THAT THERE IS SOMEONE IN OUR FAMILY FROM WHOM WE COULD LEARN LESSONS AND IMPLEMENT IT IN OUR DAILY LIFE. ACCORDING TO ME, MARRIAGE IS NOT DEPENDED ON COLOR OR TEXTURE INSTEAD THE INNER HEARTS ARE THE ONE WHO JOIN THE TWO LOVERS. ONE SHOULD LOOK AT THE INNER SIDE OF THE HUMAN BEING.

I never dated someone who is non white, but my friend dated James, who is non white. Their relationship was not happily going. They had fights and had trust between them. Their relationship was like a glass without water. There was no love, and affection between them. This increased because of the negative thoughts. Their relationship was treated differently than those relationships between people of the same race. The people generally thought that the people who are of the same race have the same

thoughts and feelings then compared to those of the different race. People think that there is no connection of religion and cultural identities to those who are in relationship with different race.

This should not be taken into granted that if the people who have relationship with different race will not last longer because they are from different culture or religion in fact, one should think that religion and culture does matter at some extend, but the most important thing is two souls should be satisfied with the relationship.

I LEARNT THAT PEOPLE STILL HAVE THE IDEOLOGY IN SOME PART OF THE WORLD THAT THEY SHOULD MARRY THE PEOPLE FROM THE SAME RACE AND CULTURE. ACCORDING TO THESE EXCHANGES, I LEARNT THAT WHITENESS DOES NOT MATTER UNLESS THE PERSON IS PURE FROM INSIDE OF THEIR HEART. THE EXTERIOR COLOR DOES NOT MAKE A PERSON CARRYING BUT INSTEAD KNOWING THE PERSON FROM INSIDE HELPS TO GET THE CLEAR IDEA ABOUT HOW THEY ARE. FINAL ANALYSIS Gender/ Race Analysis

The overall messages within these experiences about male/ female or white/non-white portrayed how to act and behave according the gender personality and how society looks at you according to what they see is how they see. The messages imply about male/female or white/non-white is simply how gender shapes ones identity.

THERE IS AN INCONSISTENCY ABOUT THE GENDER ROLE IN THE SOCIETY THAT A MALE SHOULD BE WORKING FOR BRINGING MONEY TO THE HOME WHEREAS A FEMALE SHOULD BE AT HOME NURTURING THE CHILDREN AND COOKING.

ACCORDING TO ME THESE ROLES AND THEIR IMPOSITION ARE CHANGING AS PEOPLE ARE MOVING FORWARD FROM THE OLD MENTALITY. IN MODERN ERA, THERE IS NO INEQUALITY BETWEEN MALE /FEMALE IN SOME PARTS OF THE WORLD. WOMEN ARE GIVEN EQUAL PRIVILEGE AS WELL AS OPPORTUNITIES AS A MALE ARE. WOMEN ARE STEPPING OUT OF THEIR HOUSEHOLD LIVES AND WORKING HARD PROVING THEIR IDENTITY IN THE SOCIETY.

The roles for female who are white are generally taught to be beautiful and given far more advantage due to their appearance then compared to the male who are non white. This role is enforced in daily basis of life whether it is in school, college, work, or in the community. The way people think is based on how they see and what they see. People judge according to the personality and the way one acts not by the inner perspective or the feelings that one has.

## **Critical Analysis**

The overall message serves how society is constructed which eventually leads a person act accordingly. Society shapes the gender role. Within a dominant institution: family, employment, for example the girls/women who are non-whites are discriminated based on their race and ethnicity. They are not given the privilege that a boy/ men who are whites have.

THIS EVENTUALLY IMPACTS HOW ONE IS SEEN IN THE WORKPLACE NOT BY THE SKILLS OR QUALITIES THEY TEND TO HAVE BUT THE FACT THAT THEY ARE NOT TRUSTABLE DUE TO THEIR SKIN COLOR. THE IMPACT IS LIFELONG AND TREMENDOUSLY HEART BREAKING SINCE THEY ARE NOT ONLY REJECTED BY THE INDIVIDUAL BUT BY THE WHOLE SOCIETY IN WHICH THEY TEND TO LIVE IN. THEY GENERALLY GO INTO THE DEPRESSION BY THESE CIRCUMSTANCES.

IF THE RACIAL DISCRIMINATION CONTINUES THEN THE DEATH RATIO OF NON WHITE MALE WILL DRASTICALLY INCREASE DUE TO THEIR STRESS OF UNEMPLOYMENT AND ANXIETY. DEFINITELY NOT, BECAUSE THE GENDER ROLE SHOULD BE EQUALLY CONSTRUCTED NOT BY WHERE THE PERSON IS FROM AND WHAT IS THEIR ETHNICITY. EVERYONE SHOULD BE JUDGE BY "WE ALL ARE HUMAN BEING" NOT BY THE COLOR OF THE SKIN OR BY THE RACE. ONE THING COULD BE TAKEN INTO GRANTED THAT IF PEOPLE START BELIEVING THAT WE ALL ARE EQUAL IN TERMS OF HUMAN AND WE ALL PERTAIN THE SAME QUALITY THAT IS WE ARE THE MESSENGER OF THE GOD.
